Summer Activities: Cadets who are interested in future Leadership positions standby for the following summer events: Leadership Academy, Sailing Academy, CMP Rifle Camp, and Georgia Boys/Girls state. Cadets interested in Leadership Academy must have outstanding appearance in uniform, Outstanding PFT results, Outstanding bearing, and MUST KNOW THE UNARMED BASIC DRILL CARD. LA will be held from June 9-16, 2018. Cadets on Rifle Team must attend the CMP Rifle Camp and must give a \$50 deposit. Tentatively We will go the 3rd week in July. Fees will be similar to last years camp cost. Cadets interested in Sailing Academy must be a 3rd Class Swimmer. Sail Academy is held in Jacksonville Florida. Cadets must provide their own transportation. Sailing Academy will be held from June 20-24, 2018.

Physicals: Cadets who intend on going to Leadership Academy or Sailing Academy must have a physical that is current through June in order to attend. If you have asthma or need an inhaler you must be cleared by your doctor with "Cleared for all sports without restriction" on your physical. OTHER WISE YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ATTEND LEADERSHIP ACADEMY OR SAILING ACADEMY!

Class Hall Pass: Cadets should NOT be out longer than 3-4 minutes and can not use the cafeteria head during lunch. Also, CADETS MUST SHOW PROPER RESPECT TO TEACHERS, ADMINISTRATORS, CAMPUS POLICE AND OTHERS IN POSITIONS OF AUTHORITY!

Military Ball: Cost is \$25 for paid in full booster club members and \$50 for non-paid in full booster club members. Ball will be held at Brookstone Country Club from 1800 to 2300.
