Leadership Positions: Leadership positions in our JROTC program are not promised or voted on. You must earn or work toward the position you want. In other words, act like what you want to be.

Behavior: Cadets should be reminded that bullying, hazing, sexist, racist, or Anti-religious remarks of any type, (TO INCLUDE SOCIAL MEDIA), will not be tolerated anywhere at anytime. IF CADETS WITNESS THESE EVENTS THEY ARE OBLIGATED TO REPORT TO THE NEAREST ROTC INSTRUCTOR OR ANY SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR!

Tutoring: Any cadet in need of help in any class should see our brain brawl team captain to set up tutoring or academic help- Jackson Fowler, Paul King, or Elizabeth Magnuson. You may also come to brain brawl practice.

Colors: NS1 cadets may sign up and assist with morning colors. You should assemble in 1stSgt's classroom no later than 0755.

Command Duty Officer: When the CDO is performing his official duties, for example, morning colors or work detail at request of either the NSI or SNSI, you MAY NOT SAY NO. You must assist if requested.

Bridge Scholarship: New opportunity for JROTC cadets. Provides a full ride the first year with guaranteed ROTC scholarship if the cadet successfully finishes the first year. Colleges on list include: University of Maine, University of Arizona, University of Illinois, University of Idaho, Norfolk State, Savannah State, Washington State University, Purdue, University of Maryland, and University of Memphis. See CDR if interested.

Last Uniform Day: The Last uniform day for this semester is this Friday. If you are not returning to JROTC next semester you should return uniforms dry cleaned by December 18. If you are a Harrison cadet, you must return uniforms to North Cobb. No drive by drops at main office. No uniform turn-ins on final exam days.

Reserve Cadets: If you wish to be placed in reserve status you must get SNSI approval. If you are in reserve this semester you must be active next semester.

Leadership Academy (LA): Are you interested in attending LA. Better score Outstanding on the PFA Better know the Unarmed Basic Drill Card. You must pay fee in advance.

National Academic Exam: We will take the NAE on Jan 15th, 2019. This Exam offers more end of year points than any other NJROTC competitive activity. Cadets taking this exam are posted in Commander's class room, As always, cadets taking the exam and do well will get extra credit. Study and do well.

Promotions: Cadets should not concern themselves with the promotion status of other cadets. Some cadets are ready for more responsibility and some are not. The best way to earn promotion is to be professionally competent- know your job. Be on a team and be competitive. Just being there does not get it done. Be dependable, maintain your grades and stay out of trouble.
